

Support Workers

Our support workers undertake an extremely important role helping the people they support, typically who are affected by autism and / or a learning disability, to feel in control of their lives.

You must have good interpersonal skills and have a confident nature. Responsibilities will include supporting a person with their communication needs, helping people with daily tasks such as shopping and preparing meals and supporting the person to access community based services. You may be required to provide personal care, such as assisting with bathing.

Candidates must be willing to work flexibly as hours include early and late shifts including weekends, bank holidays, sleep-ins and waking nights. This is shared out amongst the team supporting the person.

The vacancies are based in North London (Haringey, Enfield and Camden) and in Southwark.

Previous experience is not required as full training will be given.

All staff will be required to undertake Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) checks and full referencing. Disclosure expense will be met by the applicant but will be refunded after 6 months of continuous employment with the company.
